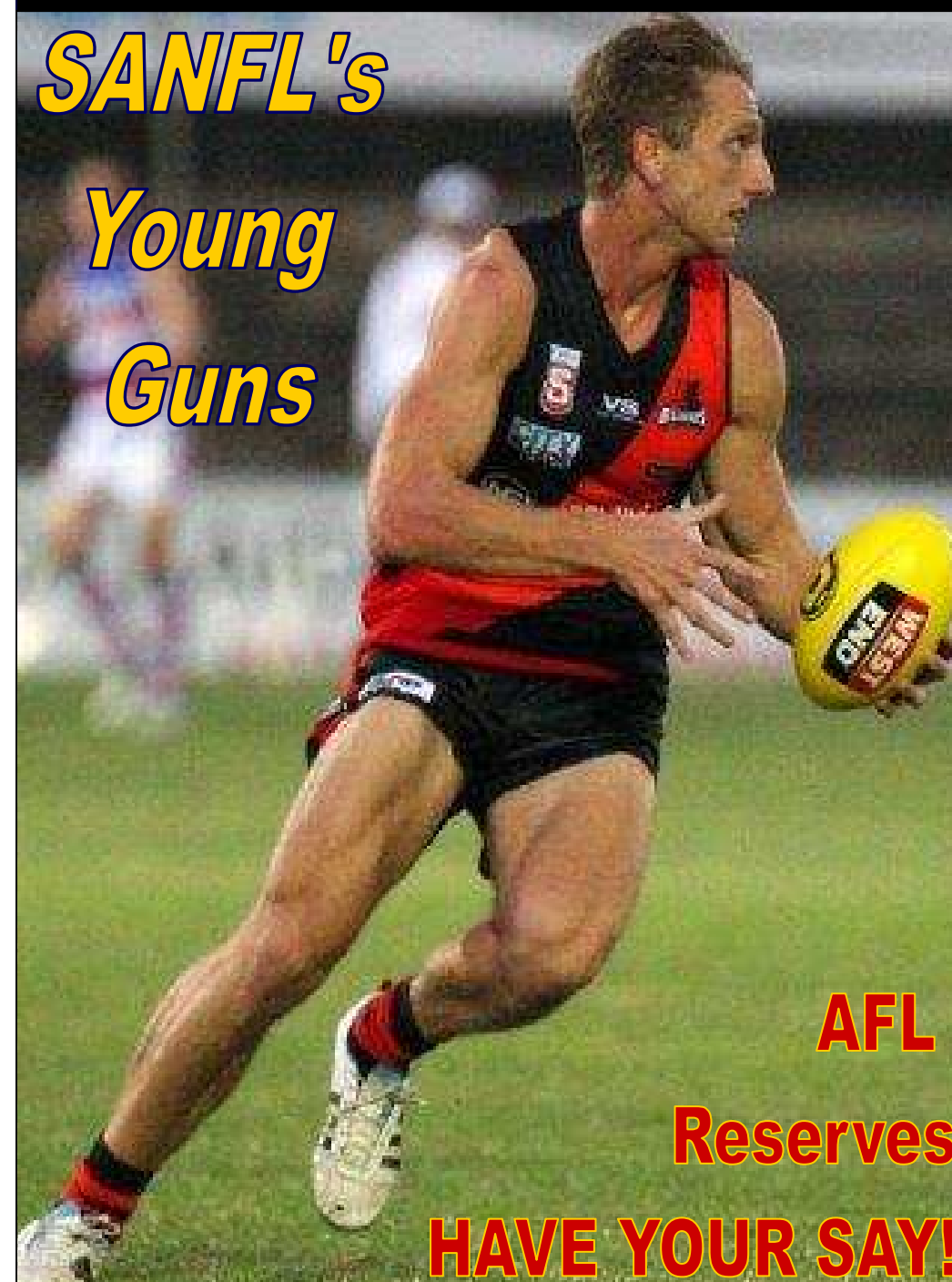

2013 YOUNG GUNS by Phil Aspinall

WITH the well documented departure of senior players in the SANFL off-season, 2013 will see the beginning of the 'next generation' of stars.

Champion players like the Gowans', Sheedy's, Clayton's, Cicolella's, McKenzie's, Allan's, Alleyway's and Gallagher's retirement will open the door for the next crop of stars to stamp their authority on our competition.

NORWOOD:

The Reigning Premiers have a pretty experienced side, but there certainly are some exciting youngsters amongst their list.

The obvious one is the extremely talented **James Aish**. At just 16 years of age when making his debut, Aish will miss the start of the season due to his Australian Institute of Sport (AIS) duties and a shoulder injury, but the 2012 Premiership player will be a valuable inclusion for the Redlegs later in the season. The midfielder/running defender will be a high draft pick in 2014.

After switching from the Magpies in the off-season with older brother Anthony, lightly built speedster **Luke Wilson** will add some exciting run and carry from half back for coach Nathan Bassett. Just 19 years old, Wilson should have a long lasting career at The Parade.

Midfielder **Trent Dumont** is also another youngster on the rise. Playing in some of the League trial games, the current AIS Academy member showed he will be a high draft pick in the AFL next year.

WEST:

A regular talent pool for AFL clubs over the last decade, the Bloods yet again have an exciting crop of youngsters that are capable of playing senior football and beyond. Midfielder **Josh Schiller**, 20, has represented South Australia at junior level in recent seasons and after a solid year of Reserves football, is ready to take the next step. Exposed to League football last season, high leaping 21 year old forward **Thomas Keough** is also one to watch for West.

NORTH:

With a raft of senior players leaving the Roosters in the off-season, there will be some very good opportunities for young North players to step up.

Having already played at League level last season, 21 year old midfielder **Max Thring** looks like he is ready to become a main stay of the on ball brigade at Prospect Oval for many years to come. Hard running, Thring can also find the goals as well and really attacks the ball hard.

Considered unlucky not to be drafted last year, 18 year old **Nick Amato**, who kicked 3 majors in the Rooster's annihilation of Central in last year's First Semi Final, is a clever small forward / midfielder with a great goal sense.

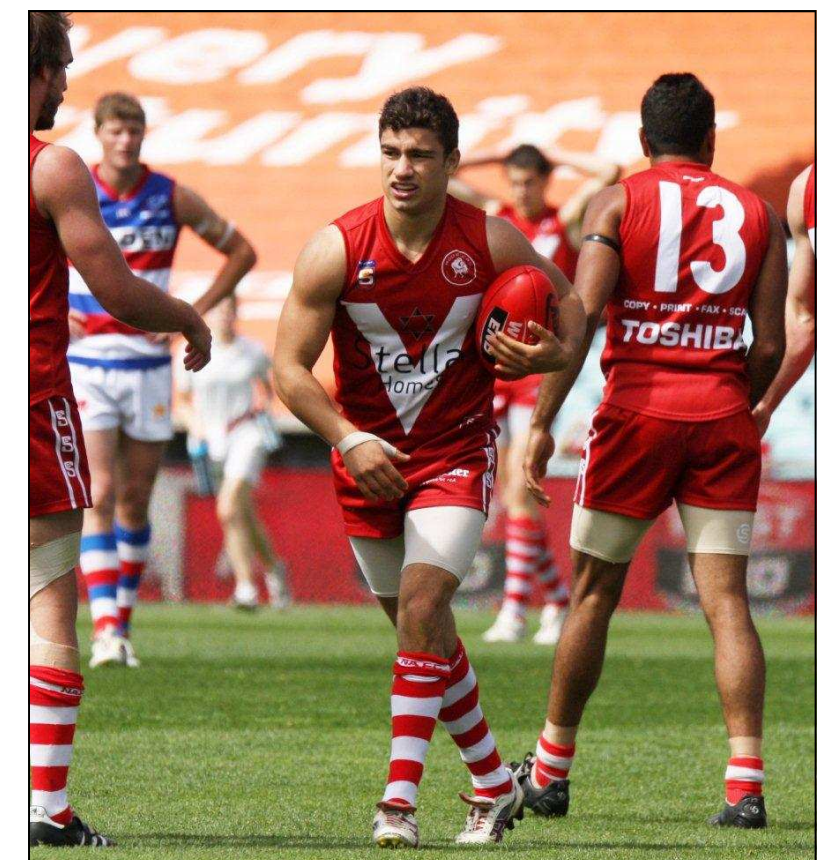
Switching from the Redlegs during the summer, 20 year old key forward **Tom Langford** will be looking to lock in the centre half forward position that Clint Alleway held down at Prospect in recent years. Langford has a great set of hands and kicks nicely for goal.

Having tasted senior football in the Foxtel Cup competition in season 2012, the strongly built **Mason Middleton** is also a very promising key forward proposition for the Bloods. At just 18 years of age, the Riverland product already stands an imposing 191cm, 96kg.

With some solid performances at Reserves level, Middleton could force himself into the League side should coach Andy Collins find his side struggling to find a marking forward.

CENTRAL:

Coach Roy Laird has admitted that the next generation of young Bulldogs stars will get their chance at League level in 2013, after a host of senior players moved on.

One star on the rise at Elizabeth is left footed key forward **Dallas Hill**. Originally from Port Wakefield, within the Eagles zone, Hill, 19, has dramatically improved his fitness in the off season, and after showing some promise during the trial games will be one to watch in attack for the Dogs.

The nephew of former Central midfielder Rick MacGowan, 18 year old on-baller **Brock Castree** is also a youngster that will get a taste of League football this year. Lacking in genuine leg speed, the Prince Alfred product has footy smarts and is a smooth mover, much like Uncle Rick. Dogs fans should also keep an eye on promising utility **Luke Buckby**. At 191cm and 86kg, Buckby was very impressive in a recent State under 18's trial game and could press for senior selection.

EAGLES:

Like The Bulldogs, the Eagles had a handful of senior players retire in the off-season, taking a lot of experience out of the side, including Justin Cicoella.

A little bit 'older' at 22, hard at it midfielder **Angus Rowntree** has already won a League Best and Fairest at Woodville. With 62 games played to date, 'Gus' is fast proving to be one of the next generation of star on-ballers in this competition, much like Cicoella was in his time at the Eagles.

After being close to senior selection last year and winning the 2012 Reserve's Magarey Medal, 19 year old Yorke Peninsula product **Angus Poole** is another midfield star in the waiting, who will certainly play League football in 2013.

Fellow midfield aspirant **Matthew Appleton** is also one to watch for the Eagles this season. After a dominant performance in the U/18's Macca's Cup Grand Final last year, Appleton is also sure to press to make his League debut.

GLENELG:

The Tigers have had an exciting group of young players involved with their club in recent seasons, with the majority of them snapped up onto AFL lists, rightly so.

There are still some very talented footballers at the Bay, none more so than forward **Lewis Hender**. The slick moving left footer knows where the goals are and has already played 19 senior games. At just 19 years of age, Hender could be a cult hero down at Brighton Road for many years to come.

Running defender **Craig Pitt**, 21, looks set to cement his spot in Kris Massie's best 21 in season 2013. Pitt is creative, uses the ball well and after 15 games of League experience to date, will certainly build on that tally this year.

Tough as nails on-baller **Andrew Bradley** had a few issues with injury last season, but at just 21 and with 38 senior games played he will be a long term star for Glenelg, and could potentially lead the club after current captain Ty Allen steps down.

PORT:

The Magpies have had a long absence from finals football and new coach, Ken McGregor, will be looking to his promising younger players to take the club into their next phase of success at Alberton.

Already recognised for his leadership qualities, solid key defender **Aseri Raikiwasa** is the next generation of star full backs in this competition. The Eyre Peninsula product is just 19 years of age, but at 191cm and 95kg is holding his own against the dominant key forwards.

Courageous midfielder **Daniel Kulikowski**, 20, has missed a few games through injury so far in his 22 game career. With an aggressive nature and selfless playing style, in the true mold of Port Adelaide, Kulikowski will be a long serving star of the Magpies.

At just 16 years of age, 171cm and 58kg, **Jake Johansen** looks like he should be racing in the fifth at Morphettville, but the diminutive small forward proved in the 2013 trial games that he will certainly be one to watch.

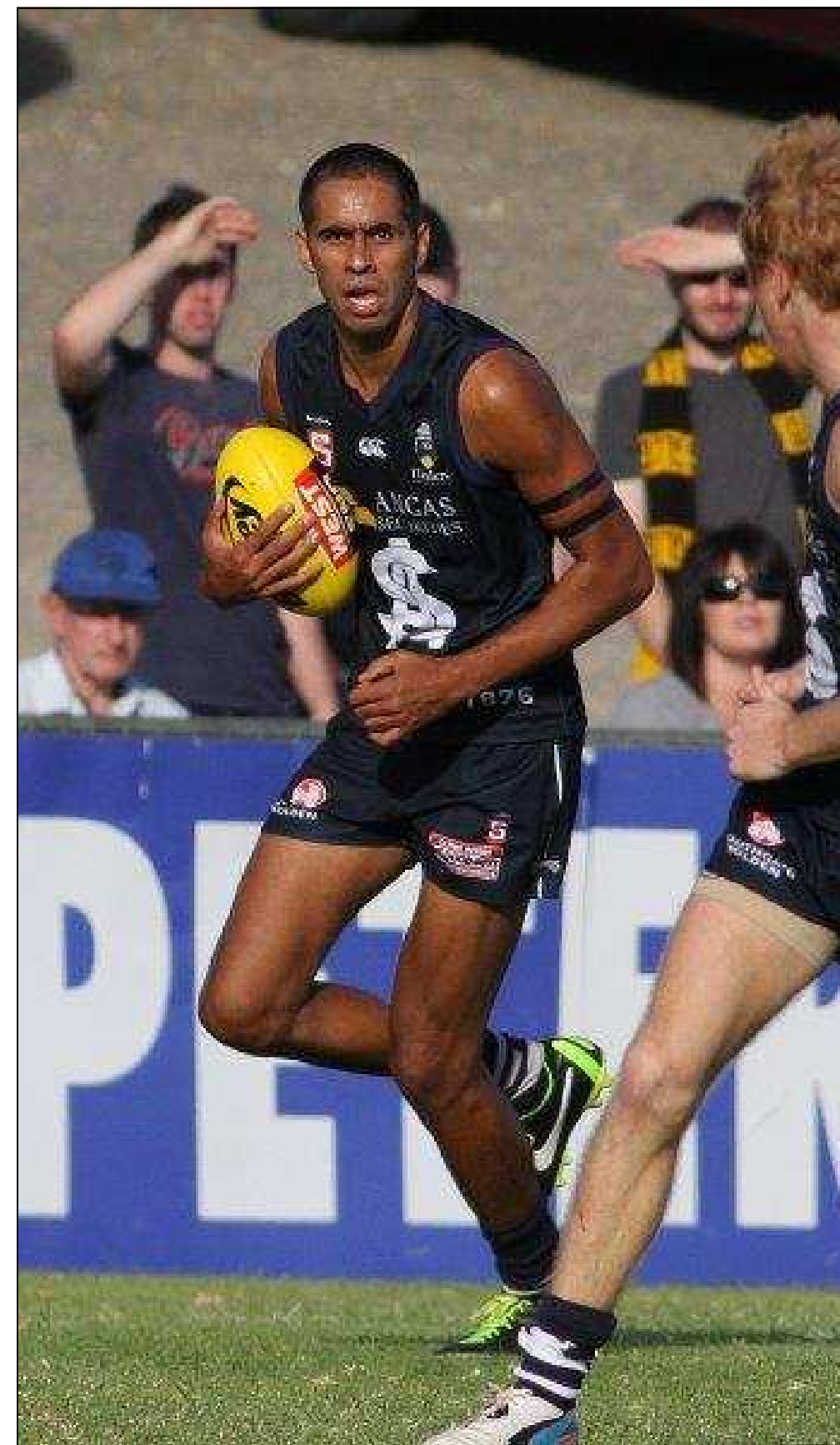


SOUTH:

With a well-established and star-studded midfield ahead of him already, the strongly built **Todd McKay** will have to be patient to break his way into the Panthers on-ball brigade. The 19 year old has made 14 senior appearances so far and has proven to be quite a handy rotating half forward at Noarlunga. The former State junior representative looks to be over his injury issues from last season and looks set to have a break out year.

Re-invented as a running defender, **Ky Miller** looks set to excite coach Ron Fuller and South fans alike with his dash from defence in 2013. The Port Lincoln product has superb evasive skills and will provide great rebound from the back half.

Strong marking forward and current AIS Squad member **Darcy Hourigan**, who debuted at League level in 2011 as a 15 year old, is also another young star to keep a close eye on when he returns from his AIS duties.

STURT: Claiming the wooden spoon last season, second year coach Seamus Maloney has some very exciting talent at his disposal again in 2013, and will be looking to give more exposure to some of these youngsters at senior level.

Lightly framed and clever on-baller **John Greenslade** made his League debut in 2012 playing 14 games, and at just 21 years of age has the potential to be the next generation of star Double Blue midfielders.

Another exciting prospect that had a taste of senior football for Sturt last year was 19 year old wingman **Levi Krause**. With 14 games under his belt last year, Krause has the ability to be a real game breaker and finishes off nicely in front of goal.

At 22, high leaping forward **Ziggy Vitkunas** came down from Mount Compass in 2012 and showed at

Reserves level last year that he is capable of kicking bags of goals, and made his senior debut late in the year.

With well over 2,000 games of League experience hanging up the boots over the off-season, there will be

even more opportunities for these young guns to ply their trade at senior level in 2013.

After having a detailed look over each of the nine clubs' senior lists, the players mentioned above should bring some exciting moments for the fans and coaches alike.
