

OUR BREAKDOWN

The biggest news for the 2014 is the introduction of a 10th team, the Adelaide Crows “State League” side. Only one of the Crows games is a nominal home match, but it’s a two hour drive from West Lakes, in Clare when they host the Port Magpies on May 4th.

Marquee Match— This is the BIG question for the SANFL in 2014, will a Crows “state league” side bring in the crowds or will AFC fans stick to following their AFL side leaving their SANFL games to being attended by just one set of supporters?

We will soon find out with their first game in Rd 1 against North, and a night game on AN-ZAC Day against the Bays in Rd 4.

They also play night games at West (May 10, July 4) & Norwood (May 16).

Probably the biggest game will be on Sat July 26th when the Crows travel to Alberton for the first time to take on their AFL rivals at SANFL level at Port’s home ground.

Other— The first ever game for a team in a Crows jumper was a trial of “possibles” against the Eagles (their 1st game as well) as a curtain raiser to the main group “probables” playing Essendon.

Now 23 years later the Crows SANFL sides very first game will also be a trial against the Eagles.

North will face some early tests with games against other top 3 sides West & Norwood ,both on the road, in the opening four weeks. The Roosters home games are bookmarked with 2 to open the season and then 4 of their last 5 at Prospect. Their 8 scheduled home games are evenly split between Saturday and Sunday with 4 each.

Marquee Match— All eyes will be on Prospect in Round 1 when the Crows come to play to see what turnout will be. Traditional high drawers Port (May 24) & Norwood (Aug 3) are scheduled for later in the season.

Other— New coach Ken McGregor gets a crack at his previous club, Port in Rd 8 (Sat May 24) before travelling back to Alberton in Rd 13. (Sat July 12).

Between June 23 & July 25 the Roosters have 2 byes and 2 away games (South & Port).

The Roosters ANZAC DAY clash against Norwood is at a venue to be determined although it is a Redlegs home game.

After Rd 13 (July 12), North only have to travel once for the rest of the minor round (Rd 16 v Sturt).
