The restructured Magpies will have play 9 games at home and 9 away next season. They will play in a key season opener against Norwood at the Parade in Round 1, travel to Woodville for an Easter Monday game against the Eagles and take on the Crows on May 4th in Clare, the only country match in the SANFL this season. All home games are on a different day to Power AFL games.

**Marquee Match**— The Magpies do have 2 home games when the Power have a bye, against South on May 17th and one of the most intriguing matches of the season, a home game against the Crows on July 26th, the first time the AFC have ventured to the home ground of their AFL rivals.

**Other**— Between Rounds 6 and 10, the Magpies play 4 of the 5 games at home but are on the road for 3 of their final 4 matches. Of their 9 home games, 4 are on the same weekend as a Power home game, 3 when the Power are interstate and 2 when the Power have a bye.
